Skier Safety Awareness

Danger are inherent in the sport and it can be hazardous. Expect variations in terrain and snow. Natural and man-made object do exist and may not be marked. Be aware of changing weather and snow conditions. Grooming equipment and snowmobiles may be encountered on any trail at any time.

Skier's Responsibility Code

There are elements of risk in skiing that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Your safety is directly affected by your judgement.

1. Ski under control and in such a manner you can stop or avoid other skiers or objects.
2. When skiing downhill or overtaking another skier, you must avoid the skier below you.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
4. When entering a trail or starting downhill, yield to other skiers.
5. You shall keep off CLOSED trails and posted areas and observe all posted signs.

KING CABIN: 925-1971. Trail head for all tours. Information, reservations, complete equipment rentals, ski shop. Elevation: 9,500'.

PINE CREEK COOKHOUSE: 925-1044. Lunch and dinner. Elevation: 9,750'.

HUNLEY WARMING HUT: Woodburning stove, hot drinks.

KELLOGG CABIN: End of Ashcroft trails. Warming hut, also used for over-nights. Hot drinks. Elevation: 9,825'.

GHOST TOWN OF ASHCROFT

PARKING: Two lots.

PRIVATE CABINS: Not for public use.

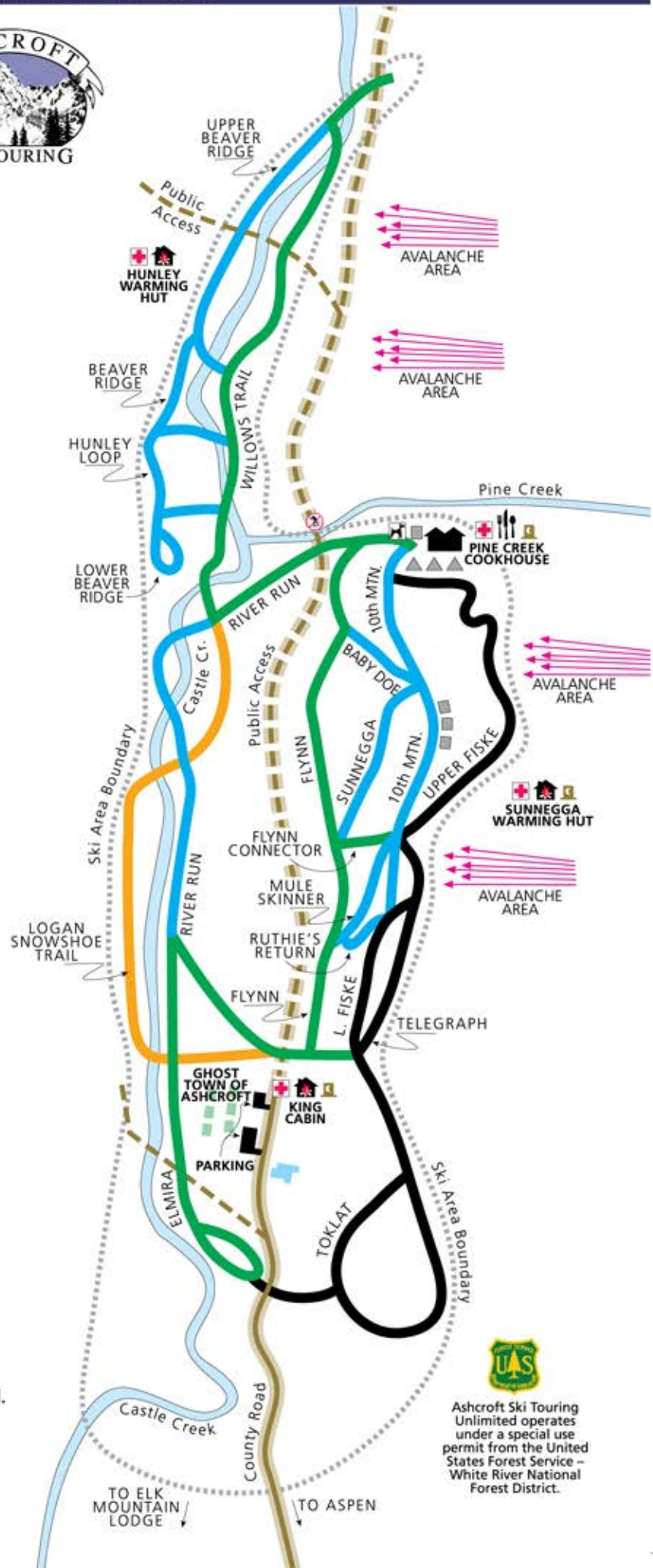
DOGS: Allowed on public access only. Dog tie up available near the Pine Creek Cookhouse.
